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JOB DESCRIPTION

PURPOSE/ MAIN OBJECTIVES OF ROLE

- To monitor and measure the quality standards of finished goods to ensure that all artificial turf products that leave the Factory are fit for purpose, in compliance with the production specification, and is representative of the Company's commitment to the highest quality standards in the sports surface and artificial turf market.
- To assist the Manufacturing Director and Production Manager in the development, implementation, review and continual improvement of quality standards and quality management systems.

RESPONSIBILITIES/ ACCOUNTABILITIES/ TASKS

- To be aware of all current product specifications, production methods, testing methods and testing criteria in relation to the production of artificial turf and in particular the carpet latex backing process.
- 2) To monitor backing plant operations to ensure that they meet production standards.
- 3) To inspect, test, monitor and measure materials, products and process equipment, including, but not necessarily limited to:
 - i) Latex viscosity & coverage
 - ii) Perforations
 - iii) Pile height
 - iv) Stitch length
 - v) Moisture content
 - vi) Tuft anchorage
 - vii) Oven temperatures
 - viii) Weight Checks
 - ix) Visual defects streaks, loops, long ends, latex on face, shrinkage
- 4) To ensure that finished goods which have passed all quality control are removed from process for onward distribution.

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- 5) To ensure that finished goods which fail testing or are rejected, are appropriately and clearly labelled and removed to a clearly marked quarantined area.
- 6) To report and discuss inspection and test data with production managers and shift supervisors as appropriate.
- 7) To maintain accurate records on measurement data, completing all QC paperwork as required, in a timely manner.
- 8) To report faults effectively and immediately; and recommend adjustments or changes where relevant. To implement changes if authorized to do so and ensure any changes are documented in the controlled management system. To implement agreed corrective actions.
- 9) To be responsible for, and liaise with the Maintenance team regarding, the maintenance, servicing and calibration of any test and monitoring equipment; and any process equipment which has a direct impact on quality control eg ovens.
- 10) To contribute to the Quality Management System, ISO procedure development, and the development and production of key performance indicators, as required by the Operations Manager and production team. This shall include attending and contributing to quality management meetings as necessary.
- 11) To participate in the ISO 9001 quality audit process, providing the necessary information and assistance to the auditors, internal and external, as required. To carry out internal audits as required.
- 11) To assist in the investigation of quality customer complaints and quality incidents as required.
- 12) To undertake any other duties which may be required from time to time, which shall be appropriate to the scope and nature of the role and the capabilities of the post-holder.


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
